'Think Tank'

Marriage Priests' Topic in Overnight Session

Canandaigua — Notre Dame Retreat House here became a "Think Tank" for some 250 priests of the Rochester diocese recently. Three separate groups of clergy were offered a 24-hour overnight refresher course centering on Christian marriage.

It was a varied, packed program which officially ran until 10:30 p.m. and then for a large number of the priests, into the wee small hours in informal groups. One of the highlights was a panel of married couples, who took advantage of the opportunity to "let Father sit back and listen to us."

Among other things the priest participants heard:

- A Catholic chaplain describe the collegian's view of Christian marriage, and the decline of interest in organized religion as he views it. Father Michael Daly of Brockport State added that even those students who worship on the campus, in their own milieu, don't relate well to their home parishes when they're out of school.

- A carefully modulated discussion of the possibility of responsible dissent regarding "Humane Vitae," which Msgr. William Shannon termed "authoritative but not infallible teaching."

- A professional marriage counselor, Stephen Maier, offer guidelines for more effective dealing with family problems.

In the evening the priests had a chance to exchange ideas on Christian marriage with married couples, ten each evening,

who were on hand to participate.

The morning sessions were given to a summary of the diocesan Pre-Cana (before marriage) program, an assessment of that program by small group discussions, and suggestions for its improvement.

It was the first time that a clergy conference was tried on overnight basis. Father John O'Connor, who heads the clergy conference committee, was elated at the positive response for this format, and termed the venture "more successful than even we had hoped for."

Lists Travelogue

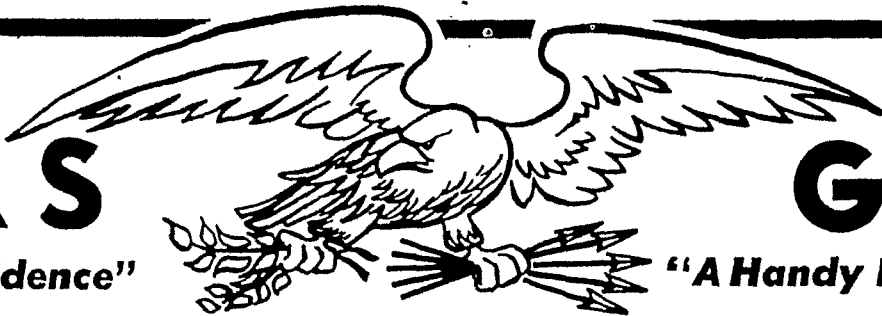
