

Drama Winners To Perform

Prize-winning drama departments of four area high schools will present their winning productions in an all-day "High School Theatre Showcase" in Sibley's Upstate Center Auditorium Saturday, May 2. Performances will be held at 11 a.m., 1, 2, and 3 p.m. They are free and public.

Students from Wheatland-Chili Central School's drama department under the direction of Edward Casey, will present

selections from Edward Albee's "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf," which won them the Best Production Award in a recent competition at the State University College at Brockport for high schools in the Rochester and Buffalo areas.

Classic Greek play Euripides' "Medea", a one hour production by the drama department of East High School under the direction of John C. Mills, 3 p.m.

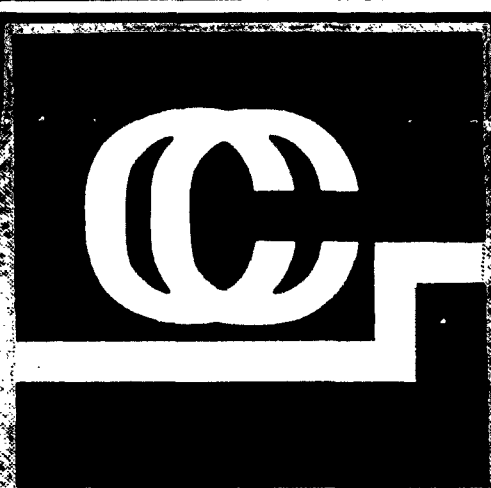
