



St. Anne's 40th Anniversary

Two Bishops and two pastors participated at Mass on Sunday, April 26, in St. Anne's Church, Brighton, marking the 40th anniversary of the parish. Pictured outside the church after the ceremony are retired Bishop James E. Keane; Msgr. William J. Naughton, pastor of St. Anne's for the last 20 years; Bishop Hogan, and Msgr. George J. Schmitt, pastor emeritus of Holy Family Church, Rochester, and founder and first pastor of St. Anne's. Symbolic burning of the parish mortgage folled the homily of the Mass.

St. Anne's Keeps Paying, Housing Program Benefits

The people of St. Anne's have paid off their debt, but the money keeps coming, in a "brother's keeper" spirit.

What might have been interest and principal paid on the parish past now buys a stake in the city's future through the Bishop Sheen Housing Foundation.

In three gifts over the past year, Msgr. William J. McNaughton's congregation has supplied \$10,000 to take care of down payments on houses. "They have responded very generously," the pastor noted.

The parish worked its way out of debt last fall, but saved the mortgage burning for the 40th anniversary celebration that took place April 26. To cap it, they added \$1,000 to a

recent \$3,000 gift to the housing fund.

Mrs. Jerome C. Cook, who oversees the work of the foundation, said the first \$6,000 from St. Anne's had put three families, totaling 30 people, in their own homes. Instead of paying rent for inadequate, run-down quarters, these families now make mortgage payments. Parishioners from St. Anne's help the new homeowners adjust to their improved circumstances.

The foundation was established in 1967, on Bishop Sheen's initiative, to give a boost to responsible people trapped in sub-standard housing in Rochester's inner city. Bishop Hogan has begun a move to extend the corporation's work through the diocese.

To date, 22 houses have been secured by the foundation for 200 Rochester people.

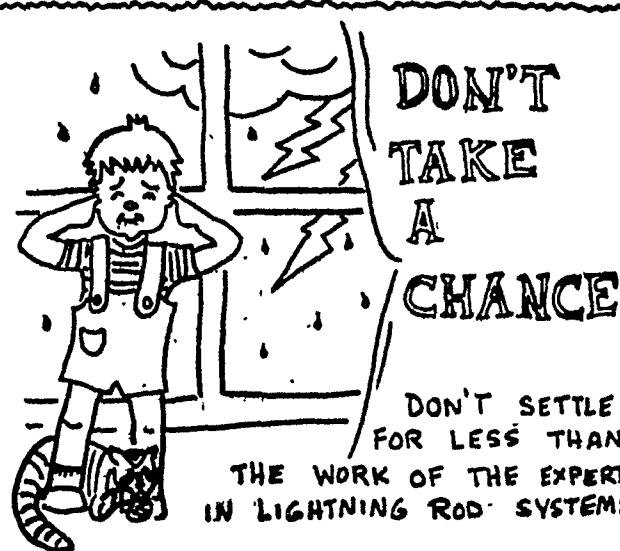

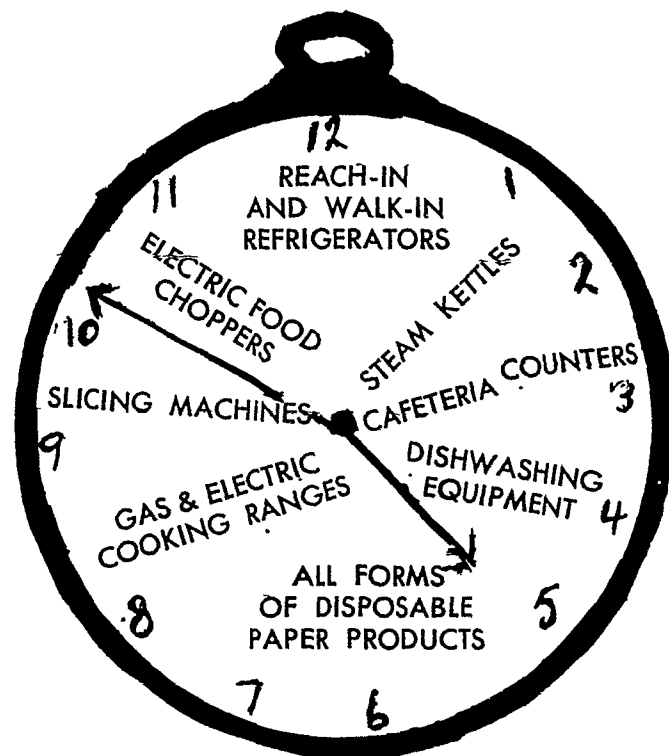
