

CCD Working On Education For Retarded

For the past several months, the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (CCD) in six diocesan parishes, has been developing a program for the religious education of the exceptional child (mentally retarded).

According to Father William McCall, diocesan director of religious education for retarded children, the program can accommodate many more children than are now enrolled.

"Our major difficulty right now is getting kids into the program," Father McCall said. While teachers are presently working on a one-to-one basis with children, they can work one-to-three, he said.

"We used to think of the retarded child as having an open gate to heaven," Father McCall said, "but these children do have an intellectual responsibility; and we need to inform it."

The parishes presently engaged in educating the mentally retarded are St. Ambrose, St. Charles Borromeo, Good Shepherd, and St. Boniface, in the Rochester area. St. Mary's, Apalachin, and St. Stephen's Priory, Geneva, are also engaged in this special education.

Father McCall noted that the CCD program for the exceptional child extends beyond preparing the child for the reception of the sacraments to offer an enjoyable experience, in which the priests and teachers become friends and confidants of the child.

Father McCall stated that he expected fully developed and coordinated programs for educating the retarded in the Faith to begin in November of this year.

He also invited parents' inquiries into the program to be sent to the CCD office, 50 Chestnut St., Rochester, N.Y. 14604.

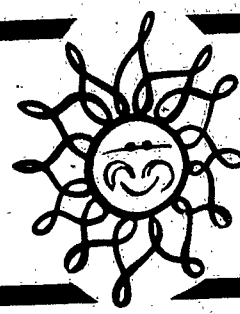
