

Mass for Sick Is Scheduled

A Mass and a special "Service of Health" devotion for the sick is scheduled at 4 p.m. Sunday, May 24, in St. Michael's Church, 869 Clinton Ave. N.

Father Benedict A. Ehmann, pastor, will celebrate the Mass and will conduct the following ceremonies for the sick, which will include a "laying on of hands."

Invited are ambulatory and wheelchair patients at homes and in area institutions. A doctor and a nurse will be in attendance at the church.

So far as is known, this is the first such ceremony in the area.

Museum to Show LaSalle Film

"La Salle: From Irondequoit To The Gulf," a color film depicting the adventures of the great French explorer, will be shown at the Rochester Museum on Wednesday, May 27 at 8:15 p.m. The program is open to the public, without charge.

The film features LaSalle's visit to this area in 1669 with a party of 20 men. Some sequences were shot at Irondequoit Bay from the new bridge and from nearby Inspiration Point. The film will be introduced by Lee McCanne, director of the LaSalle Tercentenary Commission.

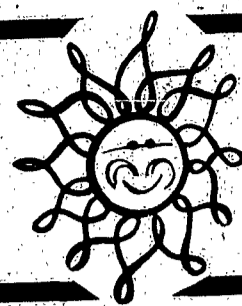
