The St. Joseph sisters in Paranaiguara, Brazil, have something coming from the women of St. Stanislaus parish, Rochester.

At a recent anniversary party, the Holy Name of Mary Society raised \$470 for the mission, under the direction of Mrs. Joseph J. Orczyk, whose daughter is assigned there. Sister Barbara is principal of an elementary and secondary school in Paranaiguara.

During a visit to Brazil in January, Sister Barbara's parents were able to see how a little extra money might go a long way toward helping the missionaries and their people. One thing Mrs. Orczyk particularly noted was the speed with which automobile tires wear out on the rough roads of the area. The sisters' one car, which is vital to them, uses up 20 sets of tires a year, she said.

Helps Neighbors**

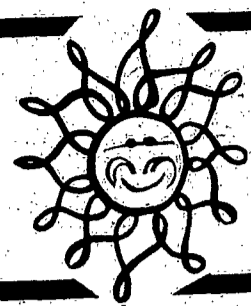
Waverly — Seven-year-old Lyndsey Scott, garnered the profits from a bake sale put on by girls in the seventh grade of the St. James religion school.
