In winning their third straight Aquinas Relays Championship, the Knights had to overcome some pretty rugged opposition from St. Joseph's of Buffalo and Christian Brothers Academy of Syracuse.

The glamorous spike-shoe carnival, now in its ninth year, was staged May 23 at the University of Rochester's Fauver Stadium.

McQuaid piled up a total of 42 points to win handily over runner up St. Joseph's who collected 27 points and CBA who placed third with 24 points. Canisius of Buffalo and Cardinal Mooney High were fourth and fifth, with 12 and 8 points respectively.

McQuaid took four out of eight first places to claim the victory trophy.

Joe Murphy of Kearney set an All-Catholic mark with a triple jump of 44 feet, 41/4 inches.

Bob Masiulis of Kearney set two meet records with a shot put of 52 feet, 10 inches and a discus throw of 151 feet, 1 inch.

Another double winner with two meet records was Al Shea of Aquinas who took the 120yard high hurdles in :14,9 and the 180-yard low hurdles with

The Aquinas 880-yard relay team of Bob Oster, Chuck Bachmann, Mike Palumbo and Tom Rapp set a record 1:33 pace. Rich Eichner hit a meet record 4:30.6 in the mile.

Dr. Arthur J. Redmond, president of the area unit, will conduct the meeting, covering election of officers and board members, and 1970 Crusade reports.


