Father Hart, principal since 1964, will remain in Rochester to serve the diocese as associate superintendent of schools.



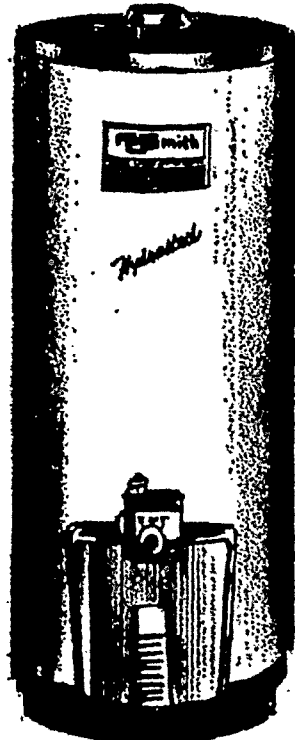
