

**Rose Garden Fete
Schedules Concert
By Philharmonic**

The Rochester Philharmonic will play in the fountain court of the Newark Rose Gardens at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday, July 7, under the baton of Samuel Jones.

The free concert will be part of a festival that opens Saturday, June 27, and continues through July 12. More than 36,000 rose bushes will be at their peak during this period.

The festival, which marks the 25th anniversary of the famous gardens, will open with a parade featuring 20 marching groups.

**Hibernians Coming
To 75th Conclave**

With the raising of "the largest Irish flag ever unfurled in Monroe County" at 8 a.m. Thursday, June 25, at Rochester's Flagship Hotel, the 75th biennial state convention of the Ancient Order of Hibernians will get under way.

A Celtic Pipe Band then will lead delegates through Main Street and South Avenue to Old St. Mary's Church, South Street, where Bishop Hogan will celebrate Mass at 9 a.m. and deliver the homily.

Delegates and friends will then march back to the Flagship for a Communion breakfast, at which Bishop James E. Kearney will be principal speaker.

Scheduled on Thursday night is a get-together at Our Mother of Sorrows Church, Mt. Read and Latta Roads, with entertainment by the Finucane Irish Orchestra and the Desmond Penrose Irish Dancers.

More than 300 delegates are expected at the conclave, which will continue at the Flagship through Saturday, closing with a dinner and installation of officers.

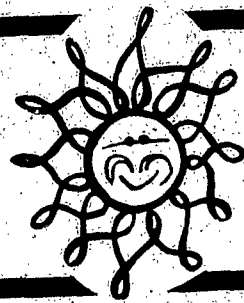
