

Kathy Van Allan Beats the Boys At Their Game



Her name gets in the papers under "Schoolboy Sports." She's been licking her weight in tennis rackets all season.

Kathy Van Allan, Cardinal Mooney High School's singles entry, has to play the boys if she wants to compete in school circles.

She won the Catholic League singles championship May 26 and played all the next day to take the City-Catholic crown.

She came in second in women's singles in a June 6-7 tournament at the Maplewood Y—second to her Y instructor, Liz Derry. Kathy foot-faulted her

way through Miss Derry's 6-4, 6-3 victory.

"I'm just getting my serve," she said. "My foot creeps."

The Cardinal Mooney sophomore, who turned 16 June 9, has been playing tennis for just half of her life. She is learning "strategy" now from the pro at the Rochester Tennis Club.

During the summer she teaches the game to youngsters in the Maplewood Y teen program, and this year she is out after a United States Lawn Tennis Association rating, to be gained through tournament play.

Kathy is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James A. Van Allan Jr., of Rye Road, and the youngest of six children. Cardinal Mooney's football quarterback, Pete Van Allan, is her brother.

This connection may have something to do with Kathy's feeling that the high schools don't take tennis too seriously. "They don't think it's hard," she said. "They think there's nothing hard about it. But there is."
