Museum Opens Herb Garden

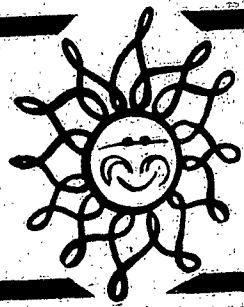
The herb garden behind the Rochester Museum and Science Center opened today with special new facilities for blind persons.
