### Commons to Seat 38 Catholics

London — (RNS) — Thirty-eight Roman Catholics will be seated in Britain's new 630-member House of Commons when Parliament resumes on July 2. This is said to be the highest total of Catholic MPs since the days of the Irish Nationalists 50 years or more ago.

Twenty-five of the Catholics are Labor members, whose party is now in the minority, and 13 are members of the Conservative Party. Three Catholics have been given posts in Edward Heath's Conservative government.

### Segregated Schools to Be Taxed

Washington, D.C. — (RNS) — The Nixon administration has directed the Internal Revenue Service to suspend tax exemptions of 43 white segregated academies in Mississippi.

Enrollments at academies are said to have increased by 300 per cent since the U.S. Supreme

Court's desegregation decrees last fall.

IRS was directed by the Administration to maintain the suspension until the schools demonstrate they are no longer being operated to avoid desegregation in the public schools.

### New Voting Age Challenged

New York — (NC) — A new law lowering the voting age to 18 is being tested here by five older citizens.

They have asked U.S. district court to strike down the law on

the ground that their votes would be diluted unconstitutionally. The suit also challenges the new law's 30-day residency requirement and abolition of literacy tests.
