

## Film Festivals In Rochester

Students at the University of Rochester and at the Rochester Free School are presenting film festivals this summer.

The Free School's offerings are being screened Friday nights at 8 p.m. at the Central Presbyterian Church, Rochester. July 17, *Freaks*, not rated; July 31, *Room Service*, unobjectionable for all; August 7, *The Victors*, adults; August 14, *The Mouse that Roared*, unobjectionable for all; August 21, *The Big Sleep*, objectionable in part; August 28, *The Battle of Algiers*, not rated.

The U of R's offering are being screened at 8 p.m. in Upper Strong Auditorium on the UR River Campus. July 18, *Tom Jones*, adults, with reservations; July 22, *The Masque of the Red Death*, objectionable in part; July 25, *Casablanca*, adults and adolescents; July 25, *The Lavender Hill Mob*, adults and adolescents, and *Oh Dem Watermelons*, not rated; August 1, *The Pawnbroker*, adults.

The admission price is 50 cents for both festivals.

## Abortion Means Excommunication

Los Angeles — (NC)—Striking out against efforts to ease California's abortion law, Archbishop Timothy Manning of Los Angeles asserted: "All the violence, madness and malice of our times are summed up in abortion."

"We tremble for our country as we pray that the justice of God will not fall on us," he said in a formal statement to the people of his archdiocese.

"Our life is a sacred gift entrusted to us by God. Its beginning and its ending are reserved to Him. The Commandment, 'Thou shalt not kill,' is the unchangeable law of God, from Sinai through Judeo-Christian transmission until this hour. No legislation of man can amend or change it."

Archbishop Manning said such divine law was "also canonized in Church law. The direct intention of destroying a non-viable fetus incurs the penalty of excommunication."
