The Summer Enrichment Program sponsored by the Sisters of St. Elizabeth operates out of three centers—Nazareth Hall, Our Lady of Lourdes Schools.

The boys and girls—students in grades 3-8—have two-hour class morning during July, exploring areas not available to them in the curriculum.

Emphasis is on creative participation, whether the topic is ceramics.

Over 2,000 students have been involved in the Enrichment Program in eight years, with this year's classes totaling 192.
