Father Daniel V. Hogan, pastor of St. Bernard's and of St. Isaac Chapel, Fleming, and St. Hilary's, Genoa, included the soldier's letter of appeal in the July 26 parish bul-letin. There was no indica-tion how he had received the letter, which was from Spec. 4C Kevin M. Smith of Texas.

Smith's letter graphically described his seeing people dying of vitamin deficiency and disease, and of children dying from malnutrition. He appealed for help from individuals and church groups as "a corporal work of mercy." He wrote he was sending the missive to churches and to drug firms."

He asked particuarly for drug and vitamin "samples" which "ordinarily only clutter up doctors' offices," and for "individually wrapped candies-the kids
