Lutherans Urge More Dialogue With Catholics

Evian - Les - Bains, France (RNS) — Continuing dialogue in depth with the Roman Catholic Church was endorsed here by the Fifth Assembly of the Lutheran World Federation.

Delegates representing 52 million Lutherans said their tradition and Catholicism should "strive for clear, honest and charitable language in all . . . conversations."

A resolution also "gratefully acknowledged" the appearance at the Assembly of Jan Cardinal Willebrands, president of the Vatican Secretariat for Christian Unity.

Presence of the cardinal, the Assembly said, was a "sign of growing understanding between Roman Catholic and Lutheran churches, as well as an encouragement to strive further toward that fellowship required by our churches for their common mission and service in the world."

Reference was made to Cardinal Willebrands' remarks on the person and theology of Martin Luther.

"As we together with all Christians pray for forgiveness in the prayer our Lord has taught us," the resolution said, "let us strive for clear, honest and charitable language in all our conversations."

The LWF and the Vatican established a joint study commission on the church and the gospel in 1967. It is expected to complete its work by 1971.

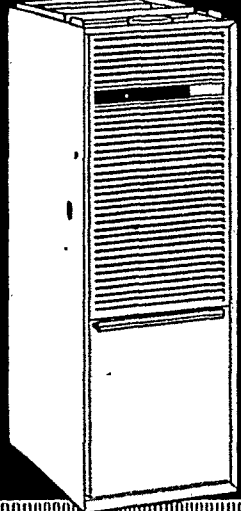
