

Auto Safety Campaign Linked to School Opening

A safety campaign designed to give special protection to the thousands of children attending parochial and public schools in a five-county area this month has been inaugurated by the Automobile Club of Rochester.

In addition to Rochester and Monroe County, schools in Wayne, Livingston, Ontario and

Yates counties are included in the effort to reduce death and injury among students, according to Maynard W. Hallman, club president.

He launched the campaign last week with the distribution of thousands of bumper stickers, posters and other literature at a luncheon meeting for sher-

iffs and the State Police at Canandaigua.

Hallman stressed the importance of special care in driving at this time of the year, when many youngsters go to school for the first time. He pointed out that 11,000 children are involved in accidents going to and from school each year and

two of every three such accidents involve children between 5 and 8 years old.

He urged motorists to give school children the right of way, slow down in school zones, obey safety patrols and show extra caution in driving near schools.

25th Anniversary For Sister Anita

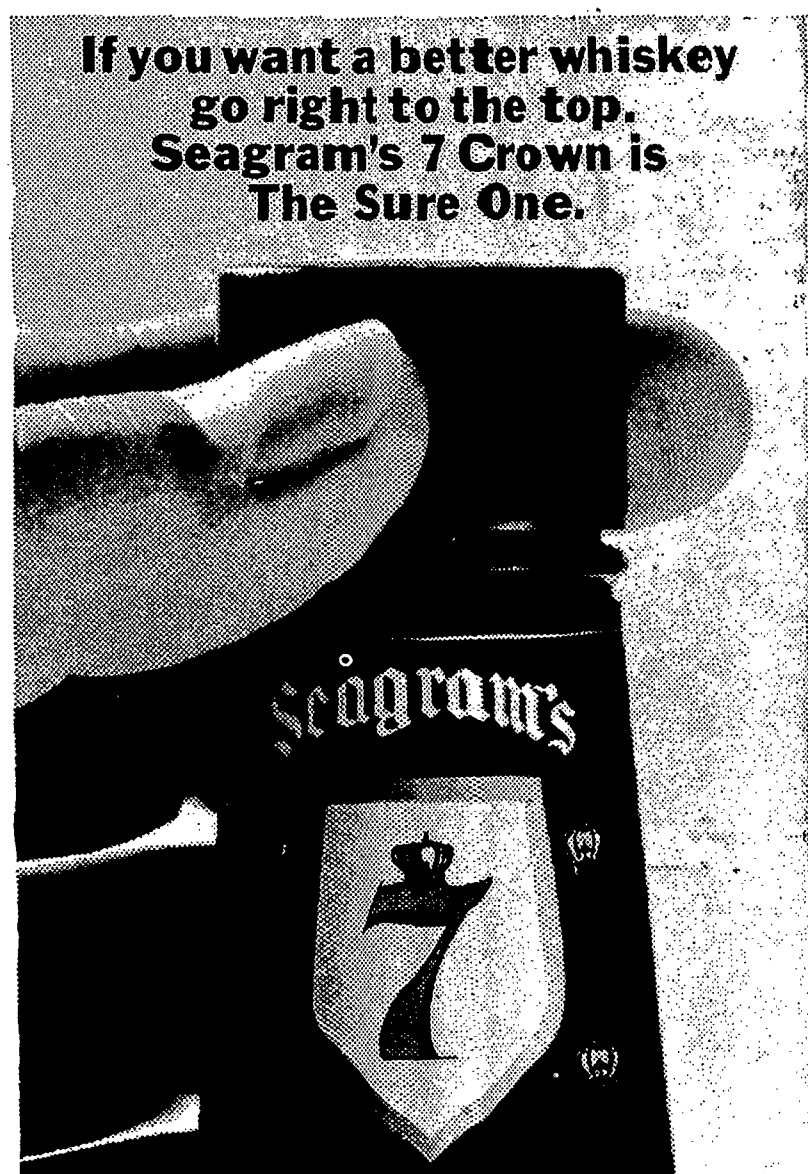

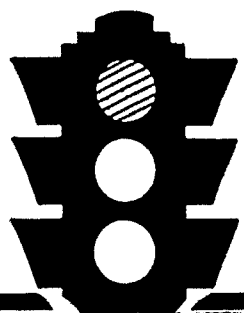
New Quarters For Seton Shop

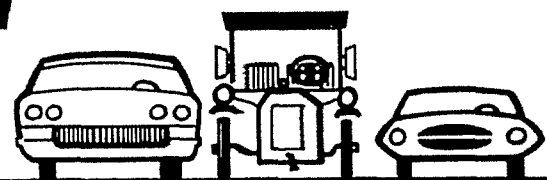

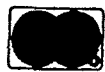

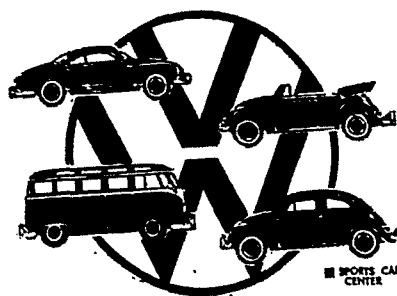
