### Father Lavery Recuperating

Father Joseph Dorsey, CSB., vice president of St. John Fisher College, will assume additional duties there this semester to give the college's president time to recuperate from physical ailments.

Father Charles J. Lavery, CSB., the president, has been advised by his doctors to limit his responsibilities for a time. He will remain at the college full time but will confine himself to business affairs.

Father Dorsey will assume full responsibility for the academic and student life of the college.

Father Lavery has been in and out of the hospital since April when he underwent an operation for torn ligaments suffered in a fall at a television Channel 21 auction.

In May he had a scheduled cataract operation, and in mid-July an operation for a detached eye retina. The retina became detached again in mid-August and Father Lavery went to Boston for still another operation.

### Ethics to Be Topic in Greece

A once-weekly night course on ethical problems is scheduled to begin Thursday night, Oct. 1, at Olympia High School under the sponsorship of the Greece Central School District.

Among speakers will be Father Robert J. O'Halloran, CSB., of the faculty of St. John Fisher College. He will talk on general ethics, formation of conflict, situation ethics and laws of freedom.

Slated for discussion on Nov. 5 and 12 are talks by Dr. Thomas R. Sweeney on abortion and the medical-moral aspects of birth control.

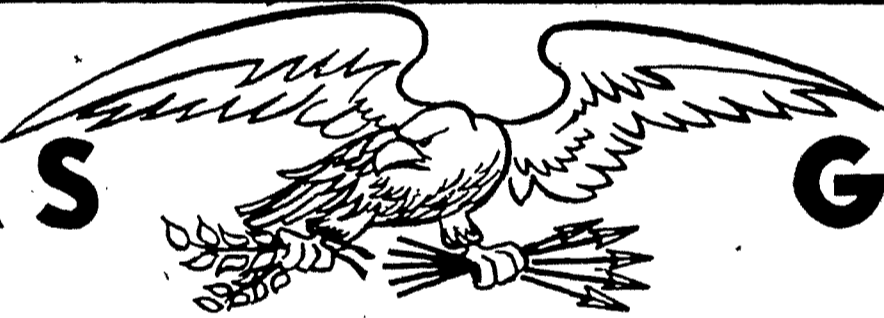
