The people of St. Gregory's parish in Marion recently had as their guest an Oblate priest whose Appalachian mission they help support. Shown speaking in their church is Father Paul Rust, OMI, of Jenkins, Ky., the only priest in a coal-mining area roughly 400 miles in diameter. Father Rust told of his parish and outside missions, one of which involves regular Saturday night Masses for a dozen people who gather in a private home 15 miles from Jenkins. Parishioners of St. Gregory's make monthly donations for this work and collect clothing for Father Rust's parishioners.
