**Recollection Day At Retreat House**

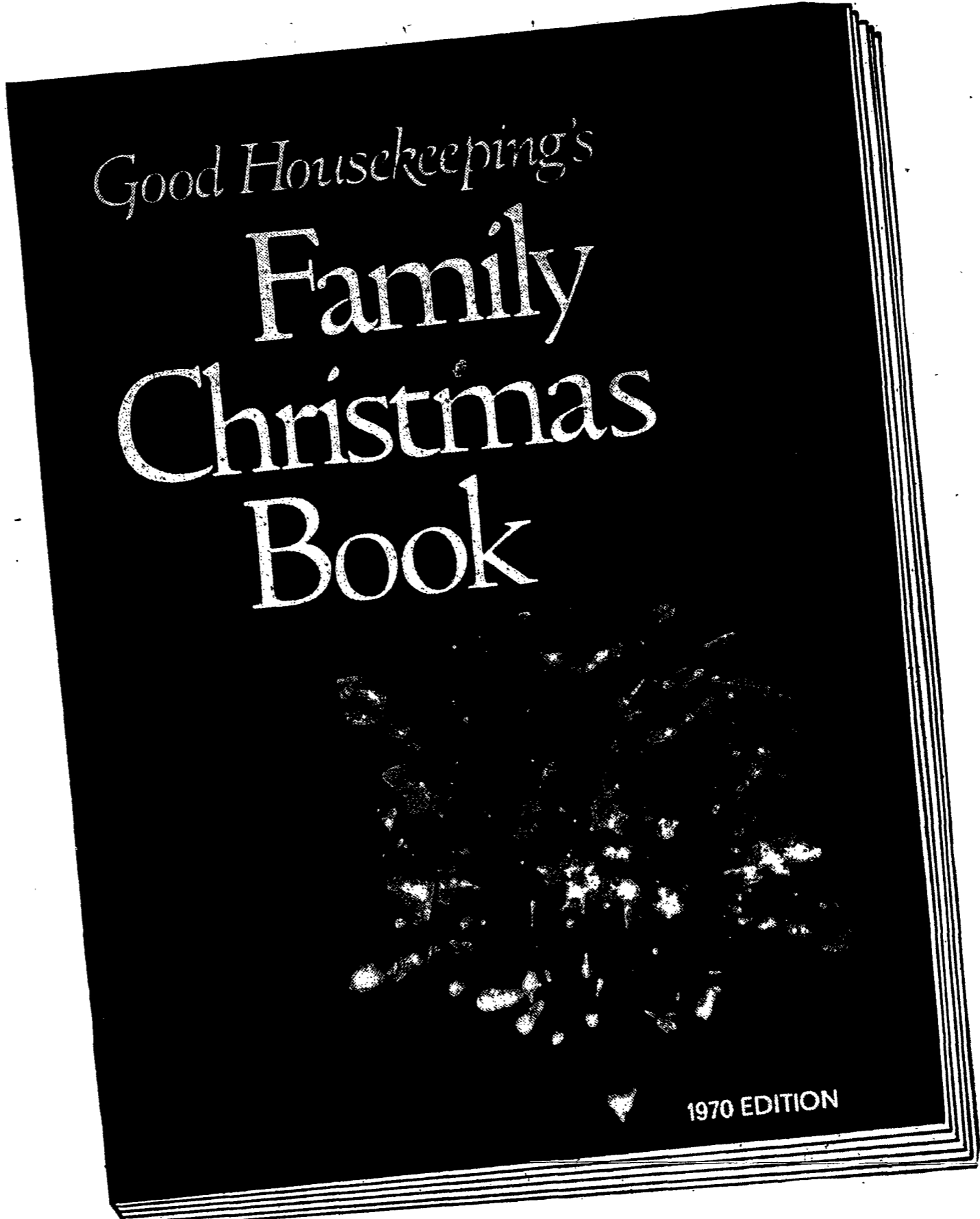
