The diaconate ordination will include portions in both English and Spanish languages. Parishioners and members of the Spanish-speaking community are cordially invited. A reception will follow in the school hall.

McQuaid Faculty Has Retreat

The entire faculty, lay and religious, of McQuaid Jesuit High School, spent a two-day weekend at the Redemptorist Retreat House, in Canandaigua, devoted to Faculty Renewal.

Following the opening Liturgy, the group was addressed by Father Francis V. Courneen, S.J., formerly chairman of the Department of Philosophy at Fordham University, and currently chairman of the Department of Religious Studies at Canisius College, Buffalo. His subject was "Contemplation and Conversion," as factors in contemporary Christian growth. Group discussion followed.

The subsequent session was devoted to the viewing of a film, entitled "The Eye of the Beholder," followed by dialogue directed by Thomas Seymour, chairman of the Department of Mathematics at McQuaid and varsity football coach. The weekend concluded with Liturgy and Homily by the rector of McQuaid, Father Albert P. Bartlett, S.J.
