Colonel Joseph Cimino of Commandery 308, Our Lady of

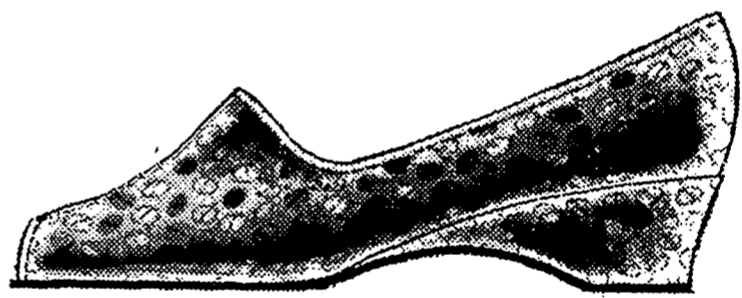

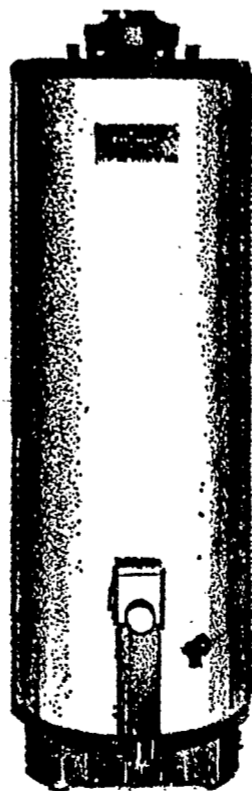
