The first thing fifth grade students learn at St. Jerome's School, East Rochester, is how to spell Capellupo. The second is fund-raising.

Their teacher, James S. Capellupo, does an excellent job with academic subjects but charitable efforts are where his classes really shine.

His 17 students have already raised \$100 for a mission in Brazil run by the Sisters of St. Joseph. The mission is run by Sister Rose Alma.

The class is well into its second project which has thus far garnered \$50 and which will be used to buy Christmas gifts for the children of St. Martin DePorres Center.

Last year's class collected nearly 1,200 towel wrappers to earn for themselves and their schoolmates 76 copies of the Rand-McNally World Atlas.

Capellupo, a graduate of the State University at Potsdam, has conducted a variety of fund-raising projects this year, including two baked food sales and a bottles-for-cash drive.

Sister Julie, principal of St. Jerome's, calls him "a dedicated teacher."

Capellupo shrugs it off. "The kids are great," he says. "They raised the money. It came from their hearts."

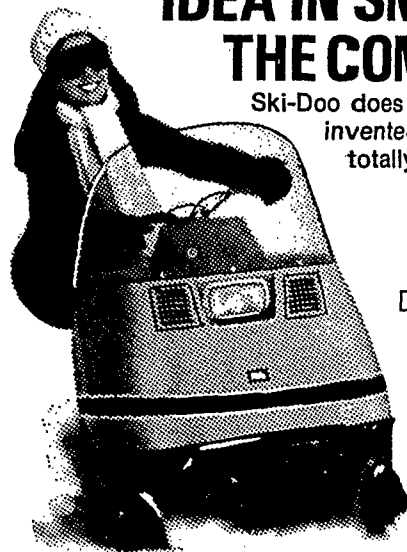
