Father Cyprian To Head Adult Education Dept.

Father Cyprian Rosen, OFM, Cap., has been appointed diocesan Director of Adult Education to be responsible for the various diocesan-wide projects of Adult Theology, Family Apostolate, Parental Education and Clergy Conferences.

In making the announcement, Father Albert J Shamon, vicar for education, promised that future programs of religious education for adults would be "offered in a professional way, interdenominational in focus and as broad as the needs of man."

Father Cyprian, resident at the Geneva seminary of the Capuchin Fathers, has been an organizer and lecturer in adult theology courses in many areas of the diocese for more than 10 years. His office for the new department will be on the 6th floor of the Columbus Civic Center with other education staffs.

The new department, Father Shamon indicated, "implies a continuation of religious growth begun in the young. We view this as only the beginning of a major educational concern in our diocese."

Sister Mary Dorothea was born in Rochester and entered the congregation in 1908. She was educated at Charlotte High School, Loretto Academy in Niagara Falls and St. Bonaventure. She taught 13 years at old St. Mary's school in Rochester and one year at St. Cecilia's, Elmira, before going to St. Andrew's in 1922.

During her first 31 years at St. Andrew's, she was both teacher and principal. She retired in 1962.

Surviving are several nieces and nephews.

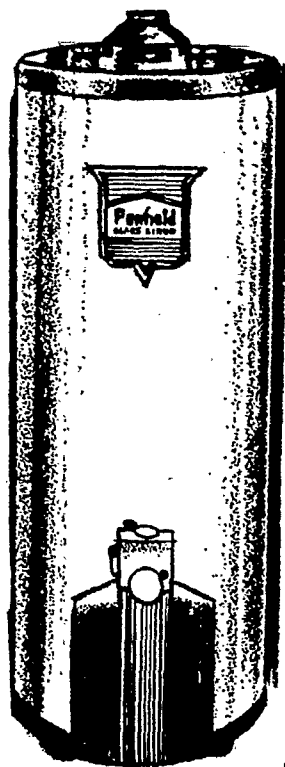
