'Titular Sees' Thing of Past

Washington, D.C.—(RNS)— Bishops who administer dioceses in the Roman Catholic Church's Latin Rite will no longer be assigned a titular See when they retire, the U.S. Catholic Conference announced here.

Retiring prelates will now be officially referred to as the "former" bishop of the diocese from which they retire.

The change in the long-standing tradition of transferring bishops to a titular, or honorary, episcopal assignment was made recently by Pope Paul and announced by Archbishop Luigi Raimondi, apostolic delegate in the U.S.

In a letter to John Cardinal Dearden of Detroit, president of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops and the USCC, Archbishop Raimondi said the change will enable retiring bishops to remain associated with the diocese where they served and continue to retain a special "spiritual bond."

Noting that the change is seemingly acceptable to most U.S. Catholic bishops, Archbishop Raimondi also requested that bishops who have already retired, and have been transferred to a titular diocese inform him whether they wish to retain that title.
