Nazareth College Praised for Action Against Pollution

Nazareth College is one of 15 industrial and educational facilities praised by the Monroe County Health Department for making significant reductions in air pollution during the past year by converting their boilers at a total cost in excess of a half million dollars.

Robert R. Bouley, associate public health engineer for air pollution control, said the conversions — mainly from coal to gas — resulted in a total atmospheric reduction of 1,348 tons of particulates (soots and dust) per year and 1,732 of sulphur oxides.

"This is positive action toward cleaning the air," Bouley said.
