

Greece School Course for Adults Focuses on Ethics and Morals

Ethical and moral problems that arise in today's society will be explored during a 10-week evening course for adults at Greece Olympia High School. Father Robert J. O'Halloran,

CSB, dean of students at St. John Fisher College, will open the series Jan. 28 with a discussion of technology as a cause of social upheaval. He will preside also at an open forum at the final session April 1.

The roster of speakers so far includes Bishop Daniel Corrigan of the Rochester Episcopal Diocese, who will talk Feb. 18 about war, riots and revolution, and Feb. 25 on the military-industrial complex.

The series is the second part of a course set up last winter by the school district's continuing education division, with the help of the churches of Greece. Participants need not be resi-

dents of the district. They may register by mail at the school office, 1790 Latta Road, Rochester 14612, for a fee of \$9.50. Meetings are scheduled for consecutive Thursdays, Jan. 28, April 1, from 7:30 until 9:30 p.m.
