Deaths

Father Leahy

The Very Rev. Anselm Leahy, OFM, Cap., who was administrator of St. Francis Solanus Church in Interlaken from 1958 until 1961, died Jan. 15, 1971 in New York City. The funeral was Jan. 19.

Father Leahy had been stationed at St. John's Church in New York, in semi-retirement, since leaving this diocese. Earlier he had been pastor of St. John's, on West 31st Street, and at Sacred Heart, Yonkers. He was born in New York, entered the Capuchin minor seminary in 1907, at the age of 12, and was ordained in 1919.

John Crowley, Julia Tobin

Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated Jan. 11 for John P. Crowley in Blessed Sacrament Church and for his sister, Julia Tobin, in St. Patrick's, Victor. Burial was at Victor, where they were born.

Their deaths occurred almost simultaneously, in separate places, Jan. 7-8, 1971.

Mr. Crowley, of 4 Bly St., operated the Highland Garage on Raymond Street for many years. He had been a member of Blessed Sacrament and its organizations since 1914.

Mrs. Tobin, a resident of St. Ann's Home, had lived most of her life in East Bloomfield. Her husband died in 1919.

Sister Wilhelmina

Sister Wilhelmina Martin, SSJ., a former teacher and supervisor at St. Joseph's Hospital, Elmira, died there Jan. 19, 1971, after a long illness. A Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated last Thursday in the hospital's Interfaith Chapel, and burial services were held at the Motherhouse in Pittsford on Friday.

A native of Holland, Sister Wilhelmina came to this area as a child and lived with her family in Greece. She entered the convent in 1913 and was graduated from St. Joseph's nursing school in 1919. From that time on she remained at the hospital.
