Elmira — Arnold Jerome, vice president of St. Joseph's Hospital, and the Rev. Robert McCune, Elmira district superintendent of the United Methodist Church, are setting up a meeting for April 2 in preparation for the White House Conference on Aging.

They are chairmen for Allegany, Cattaraugus, Chautauq, Chemung, Schuyler and Steuben counties. Their organizational meeting several weeks ago in Alfred discussed the spiritual well-being of the elderly, and their opportunities for service, as well as material considerations relating to income, housing, transportation and health.

The 14 district chairmen in New York State will compile information and recommendations for a report May 7 to the Governors' Conference. The White House conference will be in November.
