Rev. Stuart Mitchell Takes REACH Post

The Rev. Stuart Mitchell, a newly-ordained Methodist minister, has assumed the directorship of Project REACH, a Perkinsville based program of self-help for the poor, formerly run by Father Timothy Weider.

Born in Middlesex, educated at Cornell school of Agriculture and Colgate Rochester Bexley Hall Crosier Divinity School, Rev. Mitchell has served in many programs in Wayne County which attend to the needs of the rural poor.

He previously has been a Vista Supervisor and has headed the Migrant Housing Services of Wayne Community Action Program (CAP), was assistant director of Wayne CAP, and until last July, was program coordinator of the organization's health program.

Ordained last June by Bishop Ralph Ward of the Central New

York Conference, the 27-year-old father of two will assume his new duties March 15.

Father Weider To Take Post With N.Y. State

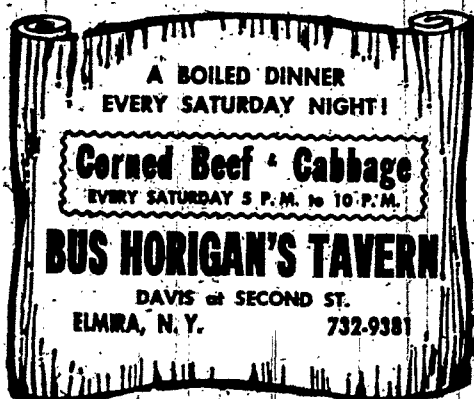

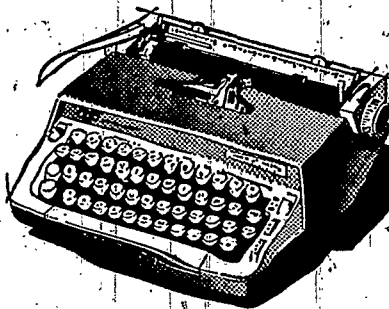
