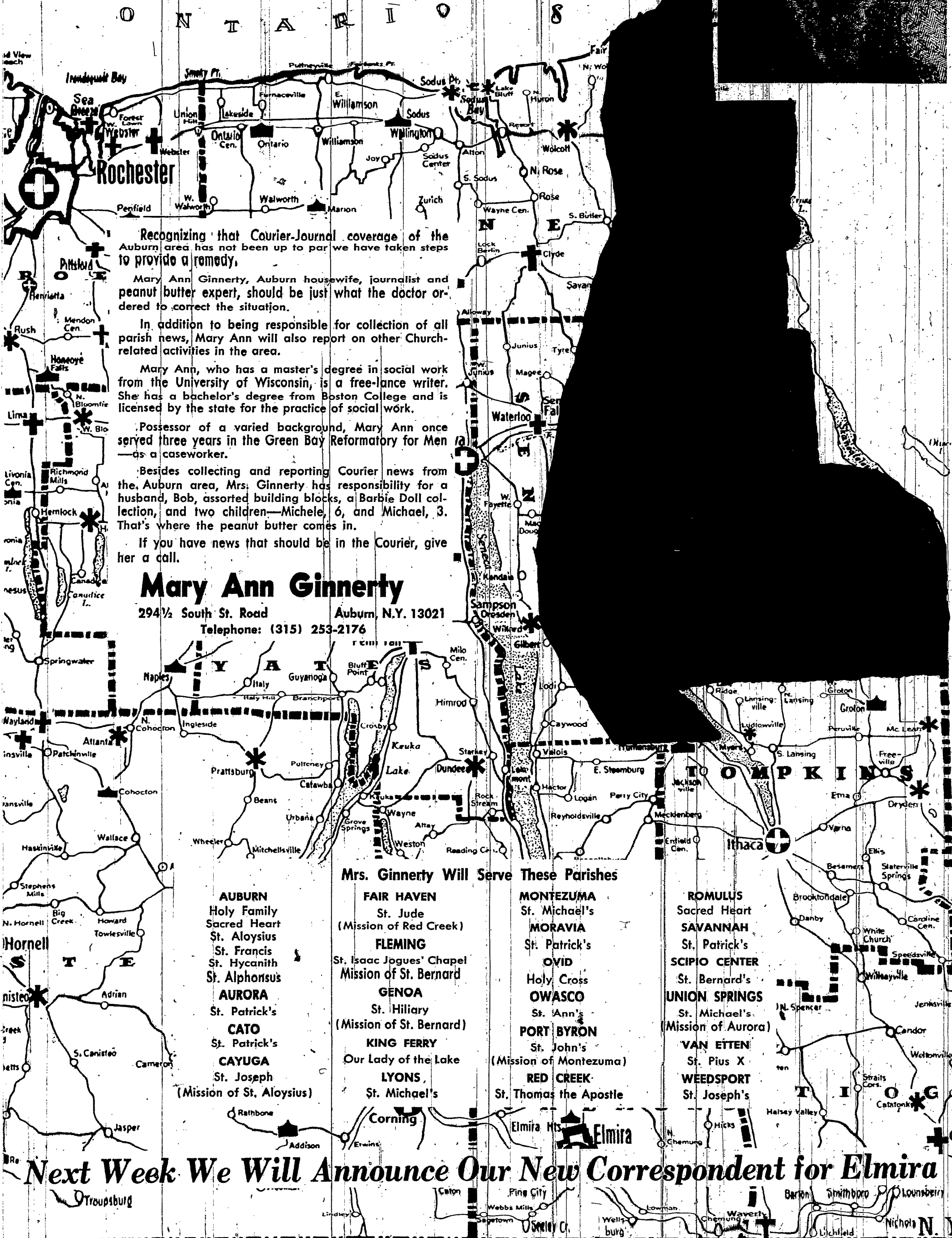


Our 'Man' in AUBURN
