Israeli Artists At Gallery

Contemporary work by 20 of Israeli's foremost artists make up Memorial Art Gallery's special exhibit for April, on view April 8-May 9.

The exhibition was assembled for the Gallery by Bertha Urdang, director of the Rina Gallery in Jerusalem, who calls it "Looking Up — Painting, Sculpture and Prints, Israel, 1971."

Among the artists included, covering almost every mode of contemporary expression, are Jacob Agam, one of the world's major kinetic artists; sculptor Menashe Kadishman, whose use of glass within metal forms creates highly improbable illusions of weightlessness; Michael Gross, described as a "lyrical minimalist"; conceptual artist Benni Efrat; and the great watercolorist Joseph Zaritsky.

Mrs. Urdang explains the title of the show: "While the metaphysics of the Return represents a turning inwards toward the time and place when Jewish peoplehood was forged, the quality of the Return and life as it is lived today in Israel represent a reaching outwards and upwards."

Peace Group Slates Fast

A lay and religious peace group has called for a week of public fasting to culminate with a "Repentance Rite" at the Federal Building, Good Friday at 10:30 a.m. The six participants have called "all members of the Christian community to join with us" in fasting for peace.

The public fast, according to participants, will express sympathy with Third World peoples, with victims of the Vietnam war and with prisoners of war.

The group decided to continue working daily while they fast, in accordance with the directions of Christ, who admonished his disciples, "When you fast, do not put on a sad face like the show-offs do."

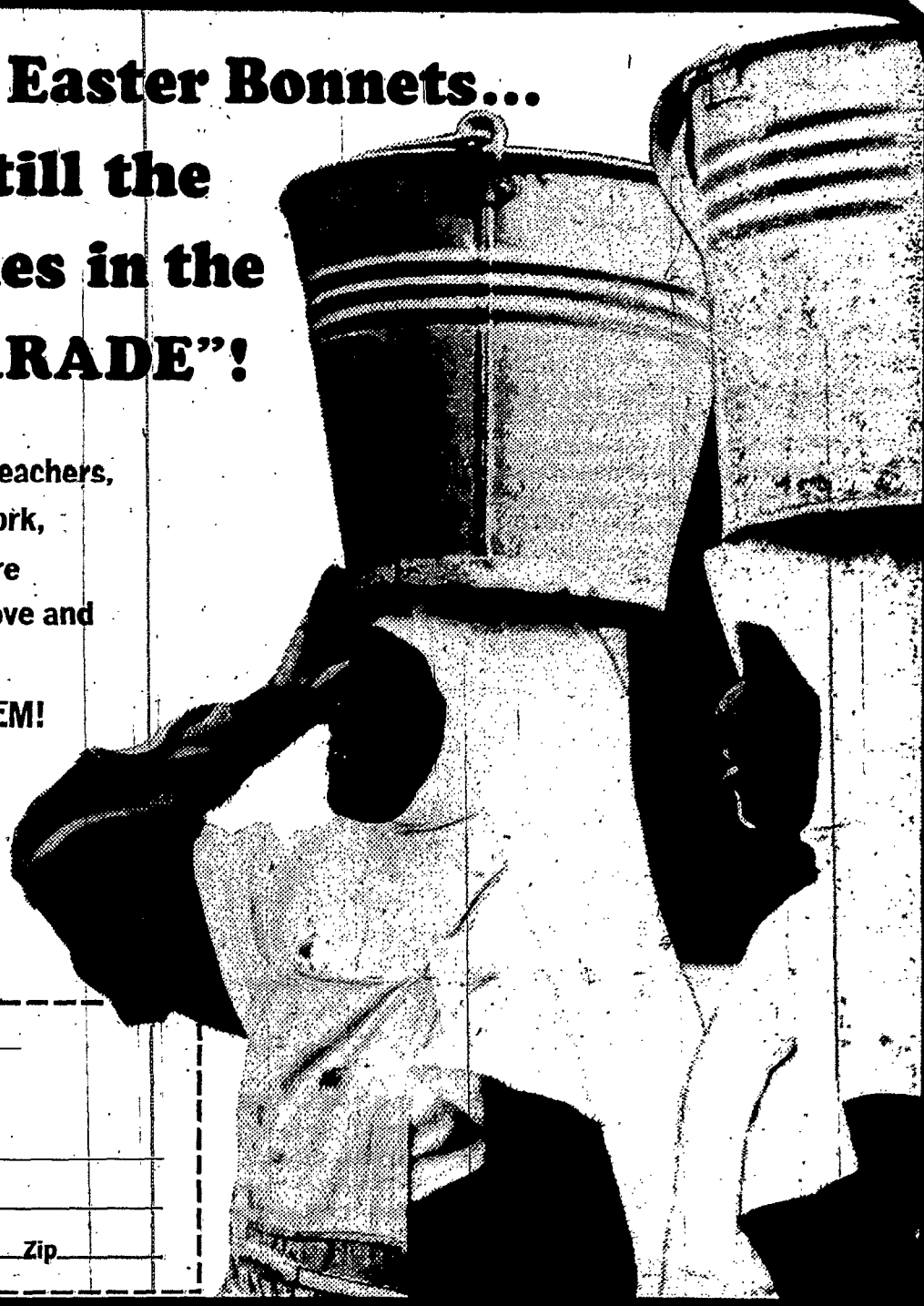
