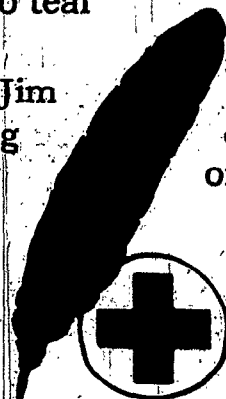
But what can a concerned working man do? Jim uses his job to fight drug addiction by giving some of the money he earns to Community Chest.
