



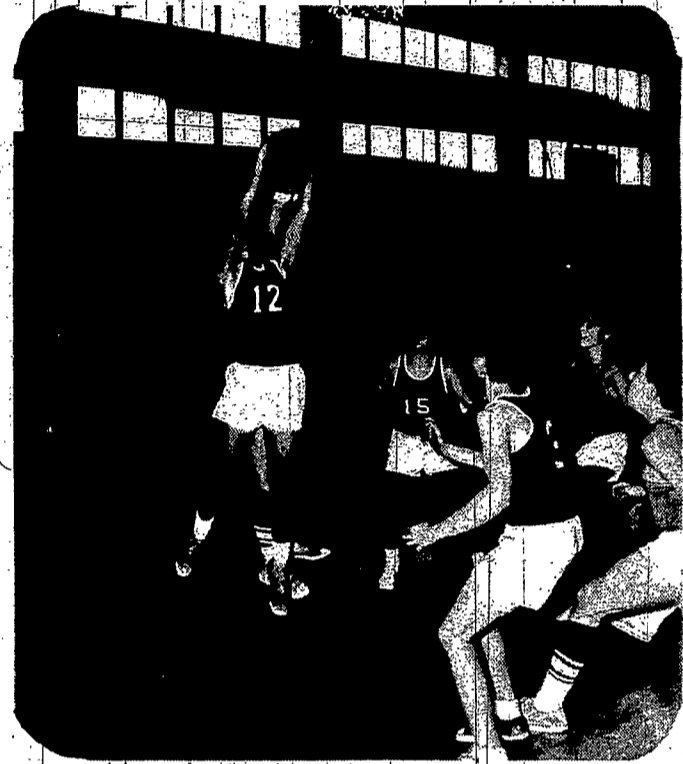
Charles House

Charles Settlement House provides service in the northwest area of Rochester. Through a strong community organization program, seven neighborhood associations of more than 500 families are actively working for the preservation and upgrading of their own neighborhoods. Over 1400 children and adults were served through the Charles House program of clubs, classes, sports, leadership training and volunteer services. A summer day camp program serving 170 children was completed by a summer activity program serving almost 75 children.



Genesee House

Genesee Settlement House, located at Niagara and Dake Streets serves part of the Model Cities area of Rochester. It offers service to people through a nursery school, a program of planned activity for children, family counseling, a job-placement program and is a focal point for community organization. Last year, over 3512 adults and children were enrolled in its programs including 265 children in a Summer Day Camp program and 63 in the Nursery School; and over 7900 home visits were made in a study of the needs of the people the Genesee Settlement House serves.



CYO

The CYO sponsors 38 different social recreational activities and physical education programs. It sponsors basketball and baseball leagues for more than 2,300 boys, hosts two cheerleading tournaments for girls in which 2150 girls participate from all over the diocese. Over 600 men and women participate in recreational activity such as swimming, handball, jogging, basketball and volleyball.

De Paul Clinic

DePaul Clinic provides psychiatric and mental health services to children in Catholic schools, agencies within Catholic Charities and the Family Court. Funded by both the Community Chest and the Mental Health Board of Monroe County, the Clinic offers a diagnostic and a treatment program to children as well as educational programs to teachers, parents and interested groups. Last year, over 400 children received service from the staff of the DePaul Clinic.

St. Joseph's Villa

St. Joseph's Villa is a cottage-type institution providing care and service for 80 children ages 6-15. In addition, the Villa operates two group homes in Rochester for 12 teenage boys no longer in need of institutional care. Children attend classes in a school which offers both an ungraded program and individual tutors to help children overcome learning problems and other education deficiencies. Last year, over 135 children received service from the staff at St. Joseph's Villa.
