# At Home with the Movies

### THE VIOLENT ONES (1967)

Thursday, June 3 (CBS)

Fernando Lamas stars (as a New Mexico sheriff) and directs in this film about a brutal attack upon a Mexican-American girl (Melinda Marx, Groucho's daughter) and the trackdown and capture of the suspected "Gringos," played by John Carradine, Aldo Ray and Tommy Sands.

The Catholic film office has no recorded rating for this one, which probably underwent a title change. The subject matter is definitely adult material, however.

### NINE HOURS TO RAMA (1963)

Friday, June 4 (CBS)

An ambitious drama about the nine hours leading up to the 1948 assassination of Mahatma Gandhi, with Horst Buchholz playing the assassin in a wild-eyed style.

Exotic scenery and locales, but very little in the way of factual content or understanding of the political situation at the time.

NCOMP rated this A-3, unobjectionable for adults.

### SERGEANTS THREE (1962)

Saturday, June 5 (NBC)

Another Frank Sinatra "Clan" film, this is a spoof of Gunga Din, with Sinatra, Dean Martin and Peter Lawford in for Cary Grant, Douglas Fairbanks Jr. and Victor McLaglen.

The setting is the American Old West, with the trio playing U.S. cavalry officers out to put an end to a cult of Indians who have pledged death to all Whites.

You either like Clan films, or you don't. NCOMP's rating: A-1.

### A BREATH OF SCANDAL

Sunday, June 6 (ABC)

A big, lavish production was made out of a minor story about a Hapsburg princess (Sophia Loren) who spends a seemingly immoral (but totally innocent) night in a hunting lodge with a handsome American (John Gavin).

There are lots of jewels, ornate Viennese settings, dazzling costumes, and an apparently disinterested Maurice Chevalier walking through his role in this tale adapted loosely from a play by Ferenc Molnar.

NCOMP rated this one B, objectionable in part for all, because "the satirical nature of this film is not a license for suggestive costuming and situations."

### SHOOT LOUD, LOUDER . . . I DON'T UNDERSTAND

Monday, June 7 (ABC)

A poorly-made, poorly-conceived Italian comedy starring Marcello Mastroianni as a Walter Mitty type. Raquel Welch is a love interest.

NCOMP rated it A-3, unobjectionable for adults.

### NAMU, THE KILLER WHALE (1966)

Tuesday, June 8 (NBC)

A semi-documentary produced by Ivan Tors, this film

uses a slight fictional story about a marine scientist (Robert Lansing) who seeks to do research on whales, and in the process viewers get some fascinating insights on this species of mammal.

Villagers become perturbed when Lansing captures a male whale, and although the whale proves very friendly, local "villains" (one of whom you might recognize as Joe Higgins, who went on to become the famed Dodge "sheriff" in the TV commercials) do their best to get rid of the beast. All ends happily, however.

NCOMP rated this A-1, unobjectionable for all.
