Our first real home after we were married was in a neighborhood that turned out to be an exciting one.

The sound of breaking glass, police sirens and intoxicated partyers often punctured the night air particularly in the summer.

If it happened in winter, I didn't hear much. The doors and windows were closed and I minded my own business. But in the summer I minded the neighbors' business and I must say it was much more interesting than ours.

There were loud family feuds, frequent visits by the local law who sometimes stayed to drink a can of beer and militant mingling between the neighbors.

On the day we moved in I had watched fascinated as a woman across the street walked to the center of the street and picked up a dead cat by the tail and deposited it in the garbage can with nary a twinge.

She had a backbone of iron, that woman, and kept a family of six children going by herself and the help of some support checks.

But the physical and emotional burden of it must often have proved wearying. The laundry alone would be staggering and the house-keeping a horrendous task.

Several months after we moved in school let out and I saw two tents go up in their side yard. A utility service truck came and a telephone was attached to the outside of the house.

Curiosity finally drove me to ask her what was going on.

She explained succinctly: "Those kids aren't going in that house until September except to go to the bathroom and to take a bath."

Yesterday, one week after school was out I found 2 million, 367 snips of paper the kindergarten had cut and sealed into a large envelope. Somehow it became unsealed under the dining room table 10 minutes before a new friend was coming for a cup of coffee. Socks, soggy shoes and wet bathing suits are scattered throughout the house. The refrigerator seems to be open on a 24-hour basis.

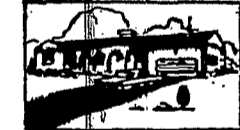
