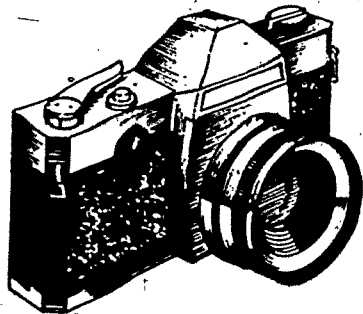

## Critic Pushes Probe Of Film Advertising

New York — A film critic for The New York Times, which is frequently quoted in movie ads throughout the country, has suggested that the Federal Trade Commission's concern over truth in advertising should extend to movie ads in which critics' comments are taken out of context.

Vincent Canby, the Times critic, claims he and his colleagues on other publications, have been quoted in ads in such a way as to lead the public to believe the critics praised films they actually panned.

In the Sunday Times, Canby

offered several examples of advertising agency distortion of his reviews.

"According to the ads for McCabe & Mrs. Miller," Canby wrote, "I found the film 'Truly Comic!' Not only have I never used an exclamation point in such a fashion — I don't think any critic has — but I panned that film, saying in passing that 'Warren Beatty's gambler-turned-businessman is a truly comic, clay-footed entrepreneur ...'"

He went on to note that ads for Who Is Harry Kellerman and Why Is He Saying Those

Terrible Things About Me? carry a quote from Canby saying "Fancily and Stylishly Put Together."

Those words, he said, "are the feeble-minded remains of a sentence that once read: 'The movie, which opened last night at the Sutton, has been rather fancily and stylishly put together by Mr. Grosbard, although I suspect much of this look comes from the look of the fancy sets and from the dozens of stylishly abrupt flash-backs that are never as revealing as they promise to be.'"

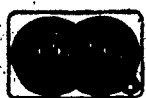
