tween July 1, 1970 and June 30, there were 37 baptisms, 20 marriages and 13 burials. Communion numbered 44,350.

St. Joseph's School was operated during that time at a cost of \$38,791.39 and it is anticipated the cost will rise an additional \$4,000 this year, Father Marvin reported. School operation took nearly 80 percent of Sunday collections, he added.

"This points up the importance of special collections. Additional school collections realized \$3,000 more than last year. We also received \$1,025 from Cohocton, Perkinsville and Atlanta," he said.

Registration at the school, he pointed out, has increased each of the past three years and will again this year. Father Marvin reported total receipts at \$96,019.41 and total expenditures of \$94,361.55.

He also praised two members of St. Joseph's staff. He stated "the person who deserves the most for what she has done for St. Joseph's during the past 30 years is Jule Madden. She has dedicated her entire life to this parish. As a matter of interest, she spent \$937.79 on the rectory table, or approximately \$78 each month . . . \$19 a week . . . and the people she feeds are overweight," Father Marvin said.

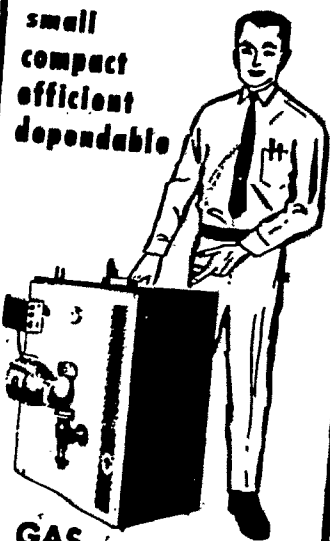

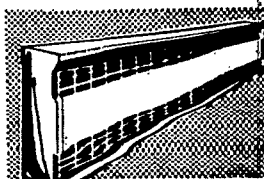
