THE PRIESTS' COUNCIL

Each month 18 elected priests meet with Bishop Joseph L. Hogan, with Rochester's two auxiliary bishops and with the diocesan chancellor to exchange thoughts on problems facing the Church and the Rochester diocese.

Known collectively as the Priests' Council, the members are elected by their fellow priests. Groups of priests elect members for age blocs, regions and orders. The Council's function is to reflect the clergy's opinions and needs to the bishop and to serve as a consultant agency on diocesan problems.
