Elmira — There's a new department at St. Joseph's Hospital here. Its letters are SPD. They stand for Department of Storage, Processing and Distribution.

The new director of the department is John Donovan, a communicant of Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Elmira.

In his new job Donovan will be supervising the distribution

of needed items to the various departments within the hospital.

The long range plans of the new department will take years to develop, but initial results are expected to be provided almost immediately to the units, floors and departments of the hospital.

By creating the new department and naming Donovan as its director hospital officials hope to eliminate some of the work currently done by the overbur-

dened purchasing department.

Stanley Douglas, public relations director for St. Joseph's, said, "SPD will enable the Purchasing Department to concentrate on their specific functions, making it possible for that department to further develop new concepts which will provide benefits in patient care and further help to contain hospital costs."

Donovan's background includes several years as a pharmaceutical sales representative with the U.S.V. Corporation. He also attended Alfred State Tech.
