# Ithaca Bids Fr. Gramkee Farewell

Ithaca — Fellow parishioners and Ithaca area friends recently gathered in Immaculate Conception Church for a Farewell Mass for Father David Gramkee. Assistant pastor of Immaculate Conception since June of 1966, he has been assigned to Our Lady of Lourdes parish in Rochester.

The Mass was concelebrated by Father Gramkee, Father John Maloney, pastor of Immaculate Conception, and Father Robert Clay. Directing the folk choir and giving guitar accompaniment was Father David Mura. Among the choir were Jeannine Brashear, president of the Parish Council, and Mike Stanley, religious education director at neighboring St. Catherine of Siena Parish. Lector for the Farewell Mass was Mr. Matthew McHugh, and servers were Stephen Loehr and Timothy Murphy.

Father Gramkee said that though he once had to ask

where Ithaca was located, the city and environs have come to mean "home." "Home" in the psychological sense as a place where there are people you love.

Luke's gospel which was chosen for the Mass, he continued, is a favorite of his, because in it the ordinary servant who has performed duties neither expects nor deserves special treatment. Father Gramkee then went on to express the belief that no special thanks should be coming his way, since he is only a servant of God performing his duty.

He concluded by praising Father Maloney for giving him support and for just being a beautiful person to live with and work for.

Father Maloney responded by stating that Father Gramkee

not only put his whole heart into a project but, also, a little bit more. If it weren't for his age, he chided, he would always think of Father Gramkee as a brother; instead, he will remain as a son to him.

During his 5½ years in Ithaca, Father Gramkee has enthusiastically entered into community affairs, particularly those relating to youth and family. He has been a member of the Ithaca Youth Bureau Board of Directors, the Ithaca Youth Problems Committee, the Ithaca Narcotic Guidance Council, and the Tompkins County Narcotic Council.

In addition he served the Bishop's Committee on Boy Scouts of America and was a member of Teen Seminar Staff at the Catholic Retreat House in Canandaigua from 1967 to 1970.
