

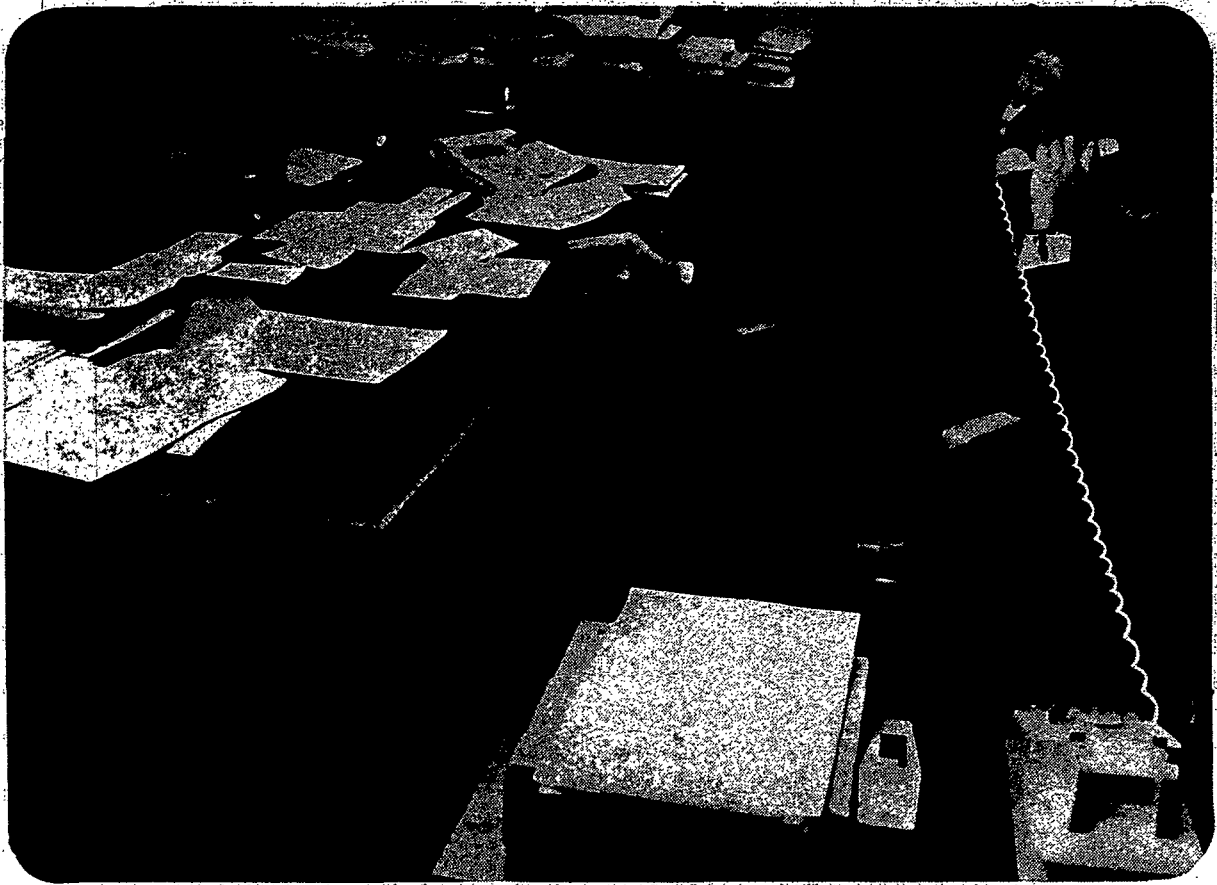
Diocesan Pastoral Office

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Working in conjunction with the chancellor is John Ritzenthaler, diocesan comptroller, who plans and supervises the budget. Four people do the accounting work. Fred Reed, Jr. is in charge of offset printing, centralized purchasing and special accounting reports; Mrs. Barbara Stifler makes up the payroll, pensions and priests' retirement payments; Mrs. Jacqueline Hamlin does accounts payable and receivable for the diocese; and Mrs. Linda Broomfield maintains the books of four of the inner city parishes subsidized by the diocese.

Much of the typing is done by two secretaries in the front office, Mrs. Julie Hoppough and Mary McLaughlin, who also greet visitors.

Since so many matters handled by the Pastoral Office involve paper work, an offset printing operation with two small presses is run in a back room.

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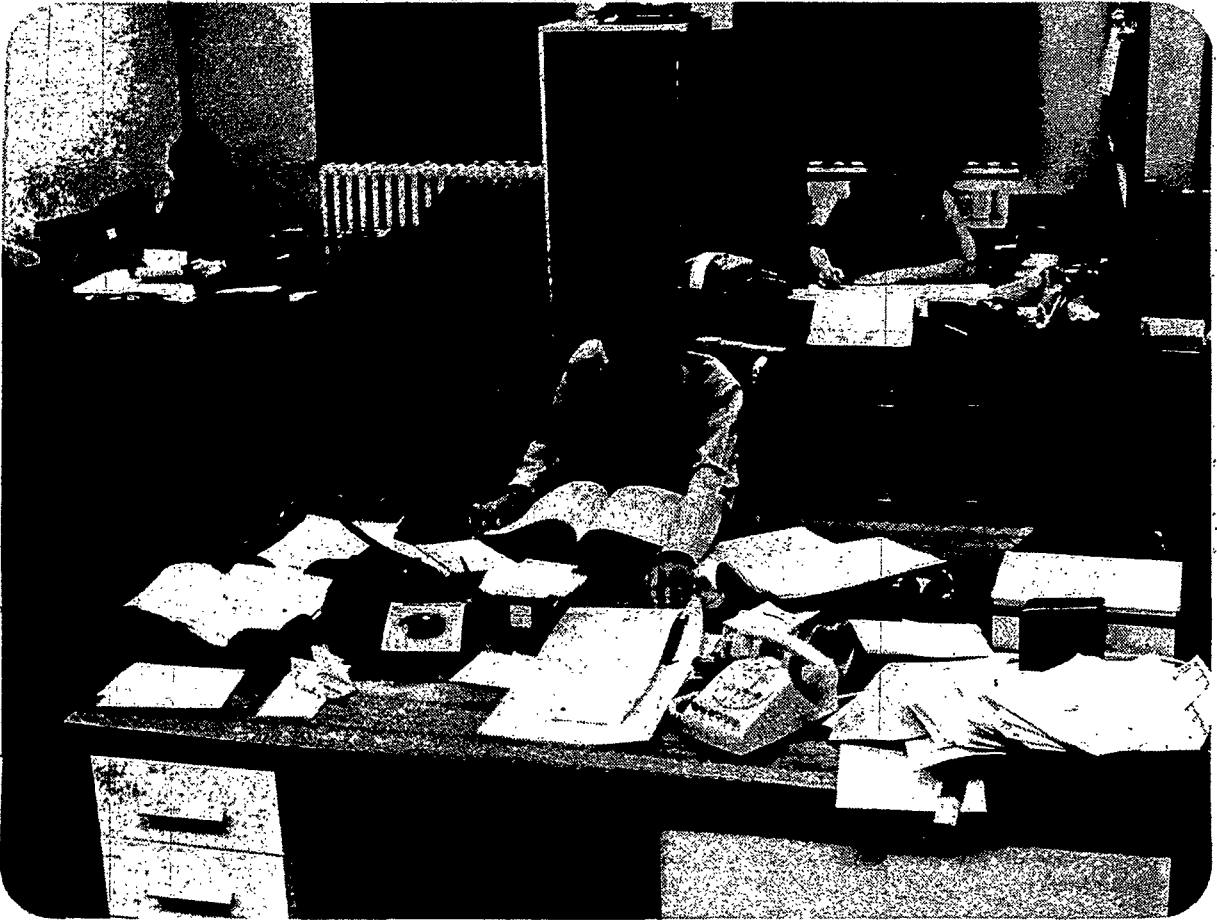
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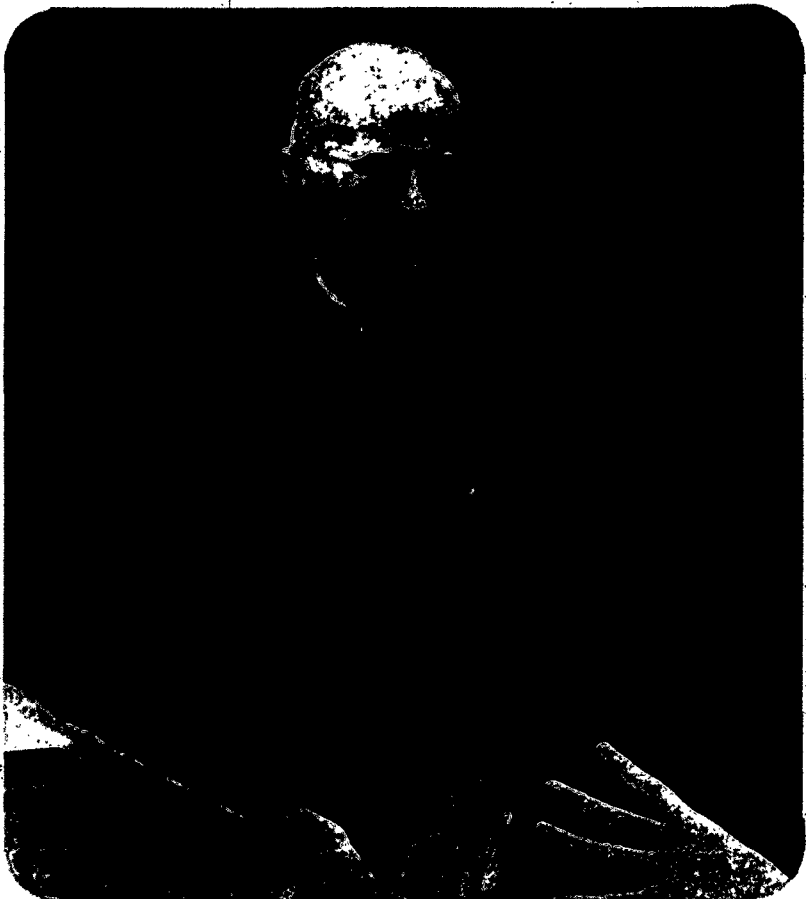
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Julie Hoppough, standing, reads the final draft of episcopal statement to Mary McLaughlin who checks another copy. Both are secretary-receptionists.
