Will Politics Hurt Church in India?

Ithaca — During a recent interview, Father Ignatius H. Rodrigues a native Indian studying hospital administration at Ithaca College, spoke of the inevitability of the current conflict between India and Pakistan. He expressed the hope that the war would stabilize a situation that has been a point of controversy since 1947, the year which marked the independence of India from Britain.

Besides the tragedy of the 10 million refugees who have fled to the area north of Calcutta and the countless war casualties, the crisis has caused a reversal in public opinion with regard to the United States.

Once held in high esteem by government officials as well as the ordinary citizen, the United States has earned the dissatisfaction of most of India. This probably will result in difficulties for the Catholic Church in India since it is regarded as a Western church.

Father Rodrigues was born and educated in Mangalore, on the southwest coast, about 500 miles south of Bombay. He is the oldest of seven children, and his parents are both teachers. Educated at a Catholic grammar school for eight years, four years at a Hindu high school, and nine years in the seminary, he is now in the midst of a two-year stay at Ithaca College where he'll graduate with a B.S. in Health Administration. Before returning home in December of 1972, Father intends to spend another three months in administrative internship at St. Vincent's Hospital in New York City.

After ordination in 1966, Father Rodrigues was sent to Lucknow in northern India for a year of parish work. He returned to Mangalore for three years of additional parish work before being transferred to the largest Catholic hospital in India, also in Mangalore, where he remained for 14 months before traveling to the U.S. to further his education. Upon leaving the States, Father Rodrigues will return to his hospital in Mangalore as its assistant director.

The 700-bed hospital—Father Mueller Hospital—was founded in 1880 and is a charitable institution. Five hundred beds are completely free; 200 beds charge nominal fees (150 semi-private rooms at 10¢ to 15¢ per day; 50 private rooms at \$1 per day). Much of the hospital's work is with lepers.

There are 2.5 million lepers in India and 15,000 of them are in the district surrounding Mangalore. Father Mueller Hospital is the only hospital in the district that treats leprosy and it has only one qualified doctor, a Sister of Charity, to work with the victims of leprosy. Two hundred beds are set aside for acute cases or children, but most treated at the hospital are outpatients.

population is Catholic, 82% are Hindu, 13% are Moslem, and the remaining are other Christians. The work of the Catholic Church in India is, mostly that of a mission — 600 hospitals (majority are 25-100 beds), orphanages, and homes for the aged. There are 8,000 priests in India. Unfortunately, because of politics the work of the Catholic Church is not as easy as it was in the past.
