## School Players Draw Plaudits

**Ithaca** - Move over Bob Hope! When it comes to producing quality Christmas programs, Immaculate Conception School will take second to none.

Recently a packed house of parents, teachers, and friends met in the new parish hall and were given a variety of Christmas treats. Enjoying the program as much as anyone in the audience were guests Father John S. Maloney, pastor of Immaculate Conception, and Sister Claire Francis, former principal of Immaculate Conception School, now principal of St. Patrick's Junior High in Elmira.

The evening began with the play "Merry Tyll and the Three Rogues," a German folk tale. The hero, Tyll Eulenspiegel, was wisdom personified. Tyll's special ability became apparent when he produced a magic mirror in which the townspeople could see themselves as others did. Three rogues enter center stage. They have knowledge that a certain Peter Simple is coming to town to sell his cow. The leader of the trio comes up with a plan to swindle Peter of his cow: they will convince him it is a goat. Peter succumbs to their treachery, and it remains for Tyll Eulenspiegel to right the wrong.

In collaboration with the townspeople he shows the Three Rogues his "magic" whistle that when blown while making a purchase will induce the vender to say "it's already paid for!"

The greedy Rogues immediately begin bargaining with

Tyll for the "magic" whistle. Only when the Rogues agree to pay 100 gold pieces and Peter Simple's cow to Tyll Eulenspiegel is the sale completed and the "magic" whistle turned over to the Three Rogues. But it is not long before the Rogues begin to realize they have been "had." Because they have attempted to swindle the venders, they are promptly hustled off to jail.

Next on the evening's program was a rousing medley of Christmas songs by the Junior Choral Group. With Sister Teresina directing and Sister Mary Lee accompanying on the piano, the children began with "We Wish You a Merry Christmas" and ended with "Santa Claus Is Coming to Town."

This was followed by the First Grade play, "Hearts Full of Love for Jesus," by Janet Moynahan. Scene I was set in the First Grade Room where "sister" (Bridget Haskell) conducted the youngsters in a lively rhythm band routine, as well as telling them the story of Jesus. Scene II was of the Crib in Bethlehem, complete with a host of angels, donkey, cow, sheep, dove, and - of course - the Holy Family. The restless and pajama-clad Jesus (Martin Reid) needed a reprimand from the Blessed Mother as the surrounding angels, animals, and children soothed him with a rendition of "Happy Birthday."

The Christmas program concluded with the Christmas Chorus, which was directed by Mary Cooke and accompanied by Sister Mary Lee Bishop.

### Sr. M. Joseph (Mary Daly)

Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated last Thursday for Sister Mary Joseph of the Holy Spirit, at the Carmelite Monastery, Towson, Md. She died Dec. 21, 1971.

Born in Rochester, Mary Daly worked for the Eastman Kodak Co., and served as secretary to Father Joseph Cameron, pastor of Immaculate Conception Church, Rochester.

She became a Carmelite in 1913 and entered Towson cloister in 1930, after a brief tour of England, Ireland and the casino at Monte Carlo.

She is survived by a nephew, Thomas Daly, of California and a cousin, Joseph Daly, of Rochester.
