A grant of \$1,000 was made to the Addison Service Center in rural Steuben County to "expand the services of the center, which began as a used clothing store but has now expanded into other areas, such as furniture, arts and crafts."

The latest distribution from the national fund totalled \$508,-957 in 33 self-help grants. Several other projects in the Roch-Diocese had received grants in earlier disbursements from the 1970 fund.



Hammondsport - Religious instruction classes for grades 7 to 12 will be resumed Jan. 3 at St. Gabriel's.


Hornell - Members of the Women's Board of St. James Mercy Hospital made Christmas tray favors for patients in the hospital during a holiday party Dec. 14.
