

More Development Money Comes Back to Diocese

Three community service projects in this diocese received \$14,500 in "seed money" in the latest disbursement from the national treasury of the Human Development Campaign. The money came from the 1970 collection.

The Geneva-Ontario Community Action Committee was awarded \$8,500 toward the salary of a "professional community organizer to coordinate the efforts of individuals and groups within the disadvantaged community in the area of self-help economic, social and political work."

The Tioga County Council of

Churches in Owego received \$5,000 to "provide legal aid to the poor in Tioga County."

A grant of \$1,000 was made to the Addison Service Center in rural Steuben County to "expand the services of the center, which began as a used clothing store but has now expanded into other areas, such as furniture, arts and crafts."

The latest distribution from the national fund totalled \$508,957 in 33 self-help grants. Several other projects in the Rochester Diocese had received grants in earlier disbursements from the 1970 fund.

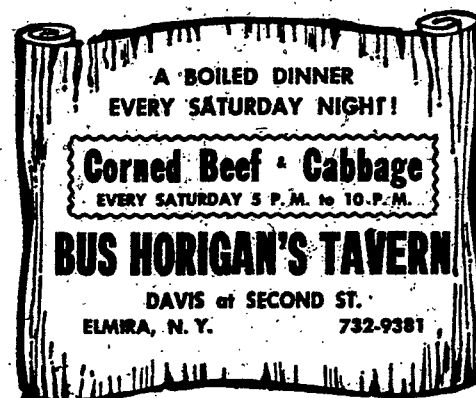
