Changes Made at St. Mary's

Dansville — Four changes in services and worship areas at St. Mary's Church have been announced. Beginning Monday, Jan. 3, morning Masses on weekdays will be conducted at 8:15 a.m.

The schedule has been established on an experimental basis until it is determined at what time the greater number of parishioners may be served. The sacrament of Baptism will be administered in an area formerly occupied by the confessional used by Father Eugene Emo, associate pastor.

Church officials explain the change is in keeping with the new concept of the liturgy whereby the baptismal font is drawn closer to the altar at which the Mass is offered.

On occasion, baptisms of children may take place during the principal Mass on Sundays, according to another new option.

Father Emo's confessional has been reconstructed in the back of the church formerly occupied by the baptismal font. Confessions will also be heard on Thursdays. The new schedule calls for hours from 3:30 to 5 p.m. and from 7:30 to 8:30 p.m.

I find it first in the kitchen where the two walls papered in October in a harvest stripe of yellow, orange and avocado delight me even more than it did when it first went up. Gray January is also improved by the new orange touch tone phone, a Christmas present for me from my husband who thought it would cheer up my kitchen even more. And it does.


Elsewhere in the house it seems harder to find anything to cheer the brain. There seems to be a layer of toys, both old and new, everywhere one steps. With the glitter of the holidays gone I notice new scribbles on what are supposed to be white walls.

So I look outward, through the windows that need a washing and focus on the white wonderland that surrounds us. From the woods to one side

comes a flock of pheasants. One by one they come all speckled females. The third to appear has a bent tail as if she had caught it in a fence.

Three brilliantly plumaged cocks follow, also in a straight line. They skirt the back yard and soon they disappear and I look away. I check again in a few minutes and I catch a sight I have not seen in the four years of watching them. Two of the females have come back and are directly under the honeysuckle bushes that border one end of the yard. The one with the bent tail makes a little jump and grabs a berry, now dried and withered on the bush. She does it again and again. My heart leaps. It is a beautiful sight.

Soon they wander away and I go to the front of the house to see how the new feeder is doing in attracting other birds. I see a bevy of sparrows, a black capped chickadee and several mourning doves. The cardinals and blue jays flit past but have not stopped to feed in several days. Snow is everywhere. A patch of blue in the sky promises the gray won't last forever. A new year begins.
