

Religion at Cornell: A Turning Inward Noted

Ithaca — New winds are blowing across the Ithaca campus of Cornell University. In a recent interview, Rev. David Callan, newly appointed Catholic chaplain, talked of some of the new trends in campus religion.

Seemingly the majority of students have turned away from the liberal/social emphasis of just a few years ago. Also noted is a movement toward religion and one away from ecumenical services and social gatherings. For example, the students opted for a Catholic-only Christmas party and retreat. According to Father Callan, other religions on campus have experienced much of the same turning inward.

There are 2,800 registered Catholics in this year-round parish and about 1,500 regular-

ly attend Sunday Mass. Two hundred of these are a stable community of professors' families and townfolk. The weekend schedule calls for seven Masses with a variety of forms — experimental Masses, folk-guitar Masses, Spanish Masses, and those of a more traditional nature. In addition, three coffee hours continue the spirit of community. The Cornell parish also conducts a Sunday school and nursery with the Episcopalians on campus.

Father Callan thought the strong point of his present ministry was the number of students attracted to the Catholic Church at Cornell, but fragmentation results from such a diverse group, he said. He cited practical problems, such as locating enough guitarists and choirs for the seven Masses. There is a cultural di-

versity — French, Irish, Latin American, Chinese, Korean are some of the many nationalities represented in the parish. Diversity is found also in the particular disciplines of the students who are from all 12 colleges on campus at undergraduate and graduate level. These stresses are not often felt in the ordinary parish, where the "pull" is usually between generations, Father Callan pointed out. In illustration of this diversity, he recounted that a group in the Medieval Studies Program came to him recently to ask for a Mass to

be said in Latin, with Gregorian chant. Attempting to answer the needs of this particular group, he is planning an occasional Latin Mass (i.e. Mass to be said in English, but songs to be in Latin).

Father Callan is assisted by two other chaplains at Cornell: Father Cesar Ramirez, who ministers to a large group of students of Spanish culture, and Sister Mary Lee Bishop, new here this school year. She is the only female chaplain on the Cornell campus.
