Ewald B. Nyquist, state commissioner of education and president of the University of the State of New York, will deliver the principal address at commencement exercises on May 21 at St. John Fisher College and receive an honorary degree.

Lavery, CSB, president of St John Fisher, announced the Fisher board of trustees has approved the granting of an honorary degree of Doctor of Laws, in recognition of his outstanding work in the state and for his close relationship with St. John Fisher College since its founding. Dr. Nyquist was, among those in the State Education Department who assisted the college in adopting its first program of studies in 1951-



Dr. Nyquist, who has held the post of commissioner since November 1969, first joined the State Education Department in 1951. He was assistant commissioner for higher education until 1955, when he was named associate commissioner for higher and professional education.


