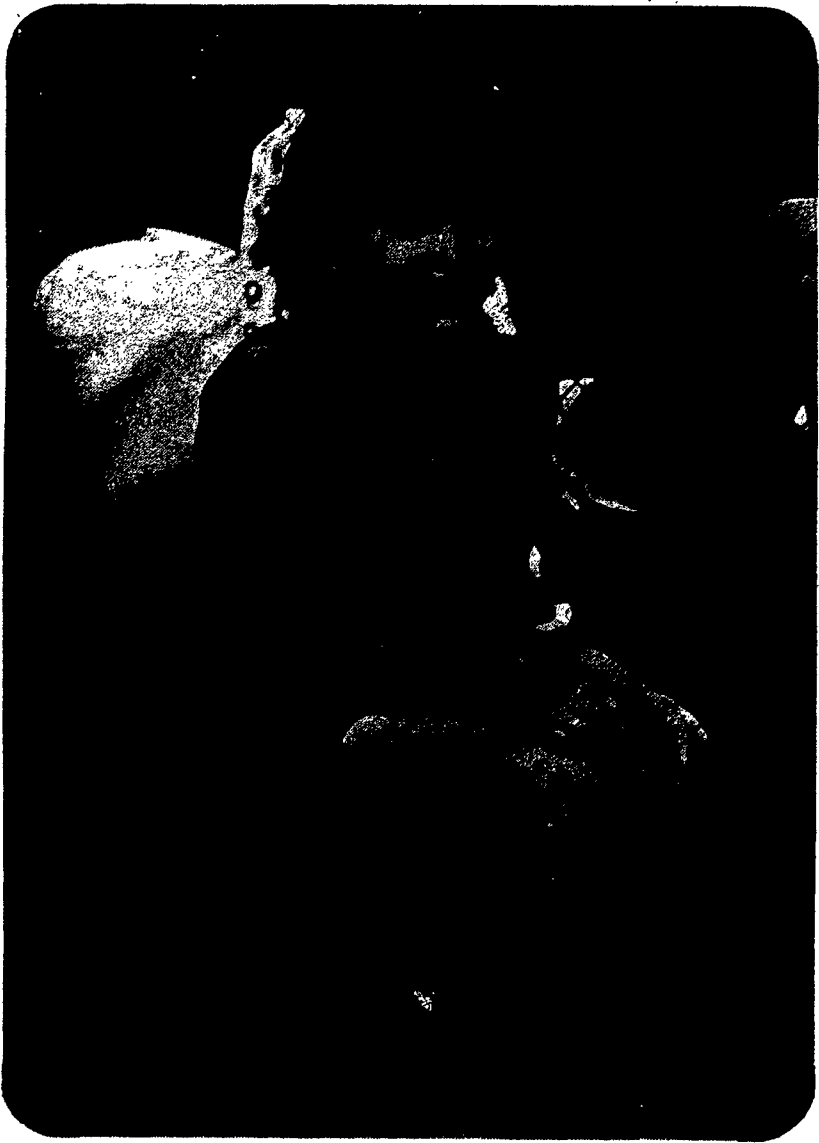


Catholic Charities A

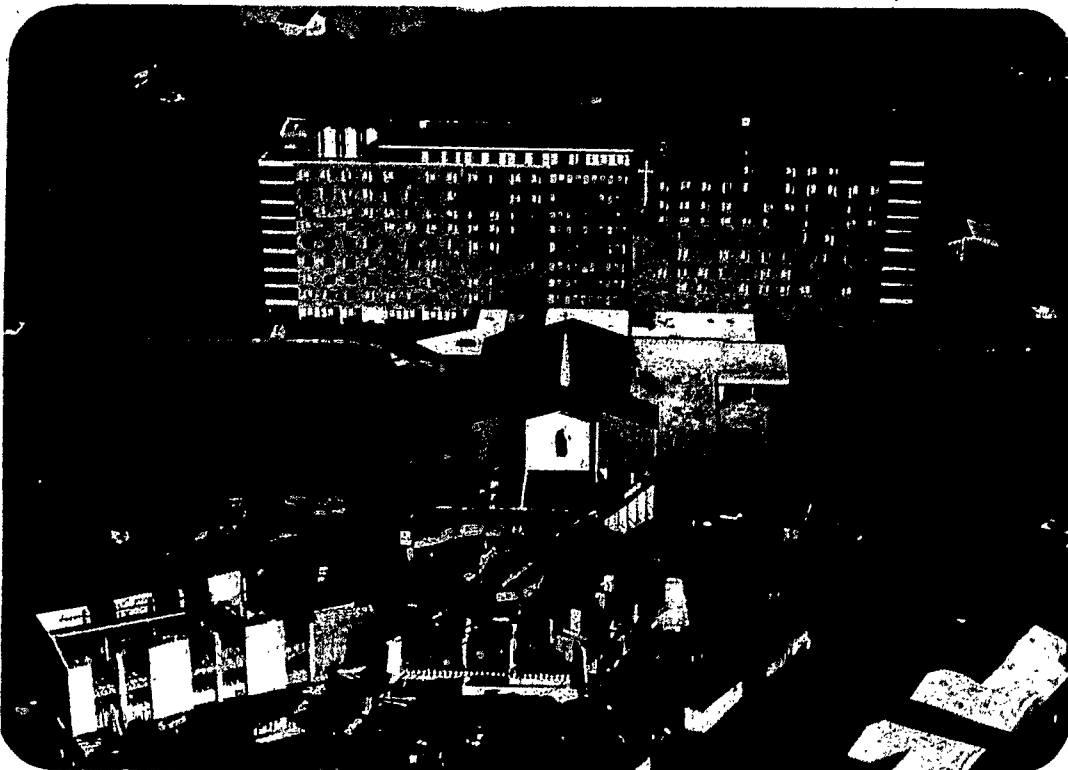
Charity Units in Auburn and Elmira

Besides the Catholic Family Center of Rochester Catholic Charities maintains two other family service agencies in the diocese but outside Monroe County. Both of these agencies render essentially the same services as the Family Center in Rochester.

The Catholic Family Service of Elmira and Chemung County is under the direction of Miss Madeline Sullivan while the Catholic Family Center of Auburn and Cayuga County has Mr. Robert McAvoy as executive director. Both these agencies participate in their local county Community Chest campaign.

St. Ann's Home

Aware of the growing need for facilities and services to the aged, the directors and staff of St. Ann's are unwilling to be content even with the operation of the present home, which provides medical, emotional, social and spiritual care for the resident. In addition to the present ten story facility, the Heritage, a 19 story health related facility is presently under construction.



Camp Stella Maris

Camp Stella Maris comes under the jurisdiction of Catholic Charities. Located on Conesus Lake and staffed by carefully selected counselors, Stella Maris has provided a rich camping experience to boys and girls from seven to fifteen years of age.



Catholic Family Center

Among their many social services Catholic Family Center offers alternatives to abortion through their counseling program for unwed mothers. They also have an adoption program for those who are unable to make plans for their children after birth.
